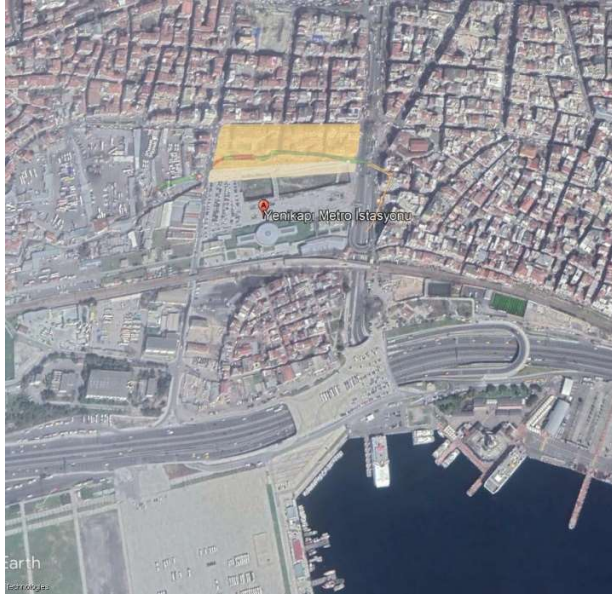

### PROJECT SITE: YENİKAPI



The concept of the **City Institute** can be defined as the areas in which the citizens are able to respond to their needs and interact with them. In this context, city institutes can be considered as centers that include lifelong learning processes, support innovation, entrepreneurship and vocational training and aim to ensure the personal development of individuals in the city. The city institutes include libraries, workshops, theaters, exhibition areas and sports fields. In addition, it can be described as an intergenerational meeting place for the citizens with its start-up centers aiming social entrepreneurship, research, innovation, and units serving maker culture.

The city Institute design scenario is expected to be shaped through the concepts of accessibility, publicity, sustainability, flexibility, urban memory and identity, environmental relations and historical traces within the scope of the programmed functions. At the same time, it is recommended that open-ended, flexible, interchangeable and adaptive spaces that are suitable for the selected functions should be included in the program.
