# SPORT COMPLEX

Architectural Design Studio VI will focus on developing a sports complex in Yedikule; which is expected to have relation with surrounding urban complexities. The aim of the project is to gain the ability to develop structural system specific to design and to address complex programs. The site is located nearby historic Constantinople City Walls, which also contains many different facilities; nearby there are university buildings and hospitals. Abdi İpekçi Sports Arena and Curling Sport Hall is located on the road axis. The location fulfills the necessity of creating variations of sport facilities for different users.

The program is expected to include sport halls, sport fields for disabled people, tribunes, indoor/outdoor gathering areas for users, changing rooms, restrooms, waiting and relaxing lounges, cafe, etc. The design should also consider creating links between the adjacent open public spaces, green areas, public transportations, nearby buildings and –surely– historic City Walls.

Each student will determine the urban complexities and derives a functional sports complex from what he/she derives from urban analysis. The program of the building and sport types is to be decided together with the instructor throughout the semester. The building form should have a close relation to the surrounding complex urban context, as well as investigate an innovative building form and a complex structural system. Universal design (a design approach for disabled people) is a must.
