A CENTER FOR HEALTH & WELLBEING IN ÇENGELKÖY



2018-2019 Spring Term Project for Architectural Design Studio 6 involves the design of an Urban Center for Health and Wellbeing. The concept of Wellbeing concerns the mental, social and phisiological health of individuals in an ecologically healthful environment. Meaning that the wellbeing of individuals is an integral part of the wellbeing of both the society and the ecosystem as a whole. The design site is in the proximity of the Bosporus village of Çengelköy and is in the vicinity of a creek formation. Students are expected to create and design a socio-petal (public) and natural environment in relation with the urban setting and the coast of Bosporus, while revitalizing the existing but topographically erased creek formation

A NEIGBORHOOD DESIGN IN KOŞUYOLU



Architectural Design Studio 7 for 2018-2019 Spring term anticipates the design of a neighborhood setting in Koşuyolu. Koşuyolu settlement in its original purpose was designed as a social housing neighborhood for the blue collar class but transformed in time into a commercial, upper class leisure urban scene. The project's aim is to rethink the original function and ontology of Koşuyolu and to design a public housing settlement within the given context. The design site is adjacent to the D-100 road at the Koşuyolu exit and overlooks the woodland of the settlement. Students are strongly encouraged to think on the public and private use hierarchy and develop their designs on the livability and social interaction concepts.
